Chairman of the Committee on Finance

Gloria Alitto Majewski was elected to the Board of Commissioners of the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District in 1984. She currently serves as the Chairman of the Committee on Finance and the Committee on Pension, Personnel and Civil Service.

Commissioner Majewski was the first woman in the District's 100 year history to be elected, by fellow Board members, to serve as Finance Chairman. She pioneered a 5% or less tax cap on the District's tax levy five years before it became Illinois law.

Since 1987, Commissioner Majewski also serves on the Board of Trustees of the District's Retirement Board. Commissioner Majewski established a speakers' bureau to educate student and civic groups on the importance of protecting the environment.

Since 2000, Commissioner Majewski has participated in the "Principal for a Day" program sponsored by the City of Chicago to meet with students throughout the year to instruct them on the importance of protecting the environment.

Commissioner Majewski is a resident of the southwest suburbs. She is a widow with two daughters and two grandchildren.
